

Support for Students from Low or Lower-Middle Income Countries

The IAPM (Interregional Academy of Personnel Management) offers a range of support programs to assist students from low-income countries studying in Ukraine:

1. **Tuition Discounts.** Substantial tuition discounts are provided to reduce financial barriers and promote access to higher education.
2. **Scholarships.** Based on academic performance or financial need, students can receive full or partial scholarships that cover tuition or living expenses.
3. **Student Loans.** International students from low-income backgrounds can apply for favorable loans to fund their studies.
4. **Affordable Accommodation and Meals.** International students are eligible for discounted accommodation and affordable meals, ensuring comfortable living conditions during their studies.
5. **Mentorship and Adaptation Programs.** To help international students adapt, IAPM offers mentorship programs, language support, and guidance for navigating the academic environment.

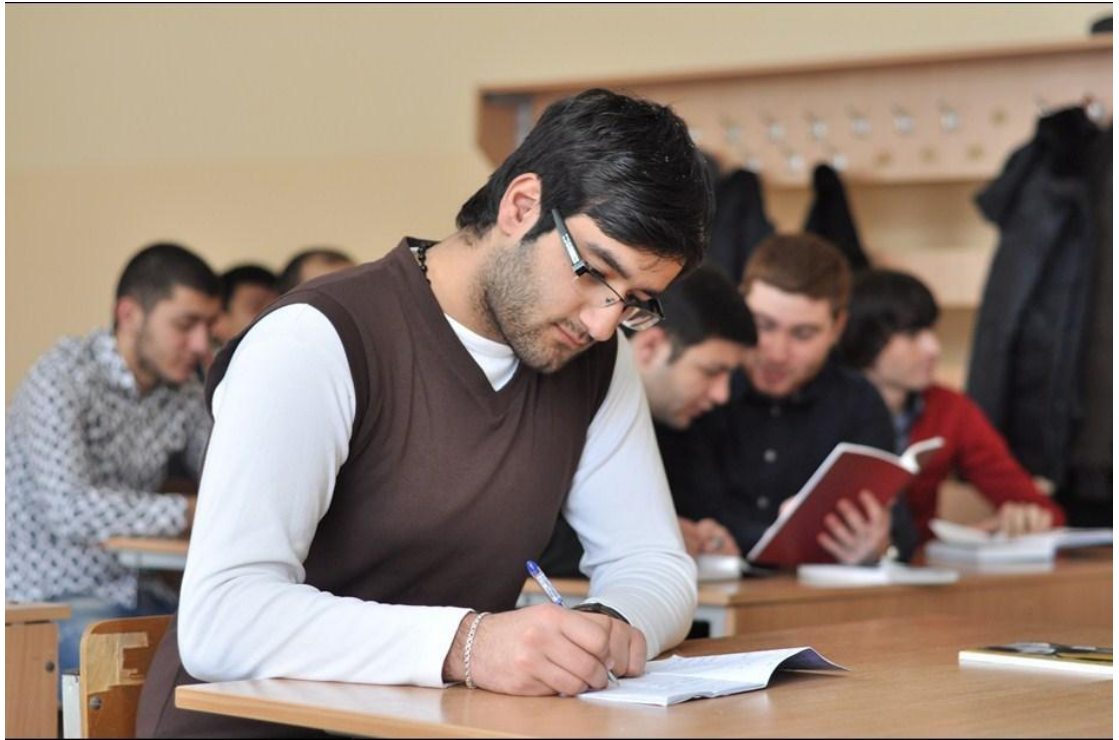






























6. **Legal Assistance.** International students can access free legal advice from the Academy's legal department and a [Legal Clinic](#) on issues related to immigration, documentation, and visas.
7. **Psychological Support.** Students struggling with stress or adaptation challenges can receive psychological assistance (<https://maup.com.ua/ua/pro-akademiya/kampus/psihologichna-sluzhba.html>) to maintain well-being during their stay in Ukraine.
