

# WASTEWATER TREATMENT

The Interregional Academy of Personnel Management's approach to water treatment protects local and regional ecosystems by adhering to the water disposal standards set by the Ministry of Environmental Protection and Natural Resources of Ukraine and the city of Kyiv.

IAPM does not emit any direct water discharges into the environment. The Academy's wastewater is treated at the municipal wastewater treatment plant of the Bortnytsia Aeration Station in Kyiv.

This station is one of the largest in Europe. The Bortnychi station is located in the Bortnychi district. It serves the entire city and has a capacity of 1.2 million cubic meters per day. The plant was built according to a modern design that includes mechanical, chemical and biological wastewater treatment, as well as sludge incineration and electricity generation.

The Academy strictly adheres to municipal regulations on wastewater and stormwater discharge, as well as to the water disposal standards set by the Ministry of Environmental Protection and Natural Resources of Ukraine. This ensures that no discharges pose a threat to health or safety, are hazardous to any person, animal, property or the environment, or contain substances that may obstruct or damage sewer infrastructure. Our commitment extends to implementing policies and programs to minimize stormwater runoff

and water pollution, while valuing water as a resource and not as waste.
